IGHS EDUCATION IS SEEKING COURSE DIRECTOR(S), GLOBAL HEALTH ECONOMICS

The Institute for Global Health Sciences Education is searching for an educator to teach Global Health Economics in the MS and the PhD in Global Health.

Global Health Sciences [201B Global Health Economics](#) (MS) and [Global Health Economics 255 Doctoral Seminar](#) (PhD).

The ideal candidate will have had experience in research and education in Health Economics with a global focus. For the purposes of our program, we define global health to be international or domestic but with a focus on health equity. Previous teaching experience is preferred. In addition, IGHS Education is committed to supporting efforts to advance equitable access to education and outreach at all levels and as a result encourages and values applicants from diverse and underrepresented communities.

Course Details:

- Expected enrollment for the MS course is 35 – 40 students and will be offered twice weekly in the spring quarter which is 5 weeks from March 25-April 26, 2024.
- Expected enrollment for the PhD course is 6 – 10 students and will be offered in the winter quarter.

Additional Responsibilities:

- PhD faculty may be asked to serve on qualifying exam or dissertation committees.
- MS faculty are required to serve as academic advisors for approximately 2-3 students per year and as capstone project readers for another 2-3 students per year
- All IGHS Education faculty are required to attend quarterly faculty meetings, a yearly retreat, and will receive student evaluations and program reviews yearly.

The position of Course Director is not offered as a campus faculty appointment and as a result is only open to candidates already employed in the UC system. The selected Course Director(s) will receive a stipend/effort for their role.
