

The UCSF Institute for Global Health Sciences is accepting applications for the [Summer Researchers in Global Health](#) (SRGH) program, a six-week summer internship for rising high school seniors from Bay Area schools. The Institute will select qualified students to participate in the SRGH program from June 10 to July 18, 2024 at the UCSF Mission Bay campus. This is a hybrid program with a 30hr/week time commitment. Students are expected to attend in-person at the Orientation on June 10th; Weekly Sessions on Wednesdays; and the Project Showcase on July 18th. Students must also have their own laptops to use during the internship.

SRGH interns receive direct mentorship from global health experts, conduct independent research projects, and attend lectures and discussions with global health professionals. Interns also participate in weekly case discussions and group activities led by graduate student instructors. Upon acceptance, SRGH interns with financial need may qualify for a stipend of \$2,000.
